



# **POLISH LOGGING CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**KOZŁOWO 19–20 SEPTEMBER 2026**

## **Regulations for Guests**

### **MPD/ PLC 2026**

#### **1. GENERAL PROVISIONS**

1. These Rules and Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”) define the rules for the organisation and participation in the Polish Loggers Championship Kozłowo 2026 in the GUEST category (hereinafter referred to as the “Event”).
2. The Event is organised by: the Municipality of Sorkwity, the Cultural Centre in Sorkwity, the Forest Districts of Korpele, Mrągowo and Wipsowo, and Przedsiębiorstwo Usługowe “Żywica” (hereinafter jointly referred to as the “Organiser”).
3. The Event is of a sporting nature and is conducted in accordance with the IALC Regulations and applicable law.
4. Participation in the Event is voluntary and constitutes full acknowledgement, acceptance, and obligation to comply with these Regulations.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to make binding decisions in organisational and interpretative matters concerning these Regulations.

#### **2. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS**

1. Only individuals who cumulatively meet the following conditions may participate in the Event:
  1. have completed a valid registration,
  2. have been accepted and confirmed by the Organiser,

3. meet the formal and organisational requirements defined by the Organiser.
  2. Participants are obliged to comply with:
    1. safety rules,
    2. instructions issued by the Organiser, judges and safety services.
  3. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse admission or disqualify a Participant during the Event in the case of:
    1. breach of these Regulations,
    2. breach of safety rules,
    3. conduct that may endanger life or health of other persons.

### **3. REGISTRATION**

1. Registration shall be carried out via the registration form available at [www.gminasorkwity.pl](http://www.gminasorkwity.pl).
  2. Valid registration requires:
    1. correct completion of the registration form,
    2. signing of required declarations,
    3. submission of complete documentation to the Organiser.
  3. The completed and signed registration form must be sent to: [pu.zywica@gmail.com](mailto:pu.zywica@gmail.com) as a scan or clear photograph.
  4. Incomplete or illegible applications may be left without consideration.
  5. The number of places is limited. Admission shall be granted based on the order of receipt of complete applications. The Organiser provides a maximum of 20 guest competitor places.
  6. The Organiser shall carry out final verification and confirmation of participation.
  7. Failure to receive confirmation from the Organiser means non-acceptance to the Event.
  8. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse any application without justification.

### **4. FEES**

1. The entry fee is EUR 100 (in words: one hundred euros) and is non-refundable.
2. The fee must be paid within 14 days from confirmation of acceptance by the Organiser.
3. Failure to pay within the deadline results in loss of the starting place.

5. The payment title must include the Participant's full name and category.
  6. All bank transfer costs shall be borne by the Participant.
  7. The entry fee includes participation in the Event and meals during each day of the Event.

## **5. LIABILITY**

1. Participants take part in the Event at their own risk and responsibility.
  2. The Participant waives all claims against the Organiser related to participation in the Event, to the extent permitted by law.
  3. The Organiser is not liable for injury, damage to health or property arising from participation in the Event, to the extent permitted by law.
  4. The Organiser is not responsible for loss, damage or theft of Participants' belongings.
  5. Participants are fully responsible for the technical condition of their equipment and its compliance with safety requirements.
  6. The Organiser ensures medical and organisational support within the scope required by applicable law and the nature of the Event.

## **6. CATEGORIES AND PRIZES**

1. The Event is held in the following categories:
  1. PROFESSIONAL,
  2. WOMEN.
2. The WOMEN category shall be held provided that at least three (3) female competitors are registered.
3. If fewer than three (3) female competitors register, the WOMEN category shall not take place, and all registered female competitors shall be transferred to the PROFESSIONAL category and included in its final classification.
4. In each category, places I-III shall be awarded with trophies and material prizes.
5. A relay competition shall be held in a mixed-team format.

6. The Organiser does not impose any restrictions regarding team formation in the relay competition.
  7. In the relay competition, the top three teams shall be awarded.
  8. Each member of an awarded team shall receive a commemorative medal.
  9. Each participant in the relay competition may start only once, and their result shall be included in the scoring classification.
  10. In the event of unused material or lack of willing participants, a second start may be permitted; however, such attempt shall not be included in the scoring classification.
  11. No material or financial prizes shall be awarded in the relay competition.
  12. Guest competitors shall not be included in the final classification of the Polish Loggers Championship.

## **7. FINAL PROVISIONS**

1. The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Regulations at any time due to organisational, safety or force majeure reasons.
2. Any amendments shall enter into force upon publication in the manner adopted by the Organiser.
3. Any matters not regulated herein shall be decided by the Organiser or governed by generally applicable law.
4. These Regulations shall enter into force on the date of their publication.
